*Jan Tully*—Jan's professional experience in the area of loss, grief and bereavement has extended over the past 27 years. During that time she has worked as an educator and counsellor for Government Departments, Community-based organisations and has been Manager Community Education Program with Tobin Brothers since October 2003.

Jan's wide experience has involved working with those who have been affected by a diverse range of life experiences including: human rights, sexual assault and domestic violence, community violence, youth suicide prevention, disabilities, aged care and volunteer caring and HIV/AIDS.

Jan has led over 700 funerals in her capacity of Civil Celebrant, and first worked in that role in 1979. She was also employed by ABC Radio locally and nationally as a researcher, consultant and producer.

Jan holds a Bachelor of Theology, majoring in Pastoral Counselling, having graduated from the Melbourne College of Divinity, Melbourne University, in 1988.
